






SELAMAT DATANG (WELCOME)





Over the past two weeks in Indonesian all of the classes have been learning about Diwali, also known as the Festival of Lights. The students have been very intrigued as to how the Hindu people of Indonesia celebrate this festival and have enjoyed creating their own rangolis and paper lanterns. Stay tuned for photos of these in the next week or so.

Diwali is a very special celebration for Hindu people and is widely celebrated in Indonesia, and especially on the island of Bali where the majority of islanders are Hindu.

Diwali is a celebration to welcome the New Year and the victory of good over evil, light over darkness and knowledge over ignorance. Diwali takes place every year and lasts for five days with the third day being the most important.

The dates for Diwali change every year depending on the Lunar calendar and when the new moon falls but is usually between October and November. The date for Diwali this year was Thursday the 31st of October.


The festival usually honours Lakshmi, the goddess of wealth. The lamps in peoples homes are lit on the new moon night, and doors and windows are left open to guide Lakshmi into their homes in the new year bringing wealth and good fortune with her.

During Diwali families clean and tidy their homes, visit the temple, light diya lamps, decorate their homes inside and outside with lights, make rangoli patterns (usually out of coloured rice, powder and flowers), prepare family feasts and put on fireworks displays.


